



**CONDITIONS OF ENTRY for
the competition: “Prize for every 100th User”**

1. General

- 1.1. Organiser of the “Prize for every 100th User” (hereafter “Competition”) is the Olympiaregion Seefeld Tourist Board, Heilbadstrasse 827, 6100 Seefeld (hereafter “Organiser”).
- 1.2. The Competition is not connected to Apple and is not sponsored, supported or organised in any way by Apple.
- 1.3. Entry to the Competition is only possible by downloading the “Seefeld wegfinder” app. Every 100th user receives an automatic prize notification which will be displayed directly on the app.
- 1.4. There are no time limits for the Competition. Entry to the Competition is possible as long as the app exists.
- 1.5. Anyone who downloads the “Seefeld wegfinder” app is eligible to take part.
- 1.6. Participation equates to consent to the participation guidelines by the participant.

2. Prize

- 2.1. Every 100th user of the “Seefeld wegfinder” receives either a Cube E-bike for the day in summer or 2 cross-country day passes for the Olympiaregion Seefeld in winter. Cash alternatives are not available.
- 2.2. Winners receive a prize notification which will be displayed directly on the app. The notification will be for winter or summer accordingly.
- 2.3. Winter winners need to show the winning notification in the Seefeld Information Office and will receive their 2 cross-country day passes directly from the staff there. Summer users who have won the use of a Cube E-bike for the day need to show the winning notification in the sports shop “Sport Norz”, Klosterstrasse 120, 6100 Seefeld and will get the bike directly from the shop. There is no defined time period for claiming the prizes and prizes can be used at any time.



3. Miscellaneous

- 3.1. In the case of unforeseeable circumstances (e.g. natural catastrophes, strikes, data concerns, bankruptcy, etc.) the Organiser has the right to adjust the prize accordingly and/or to forego the prize completely.
- 3.2. The Organiser is not liable for the usability or usefulness of the prize for the winner, nor for any disturbances or damages incurred through using the prize, should these be beyond the Organiser's control. This applies in particular to damage caused by persons other than the Organiser and its employees when using the prize.
- 3.3. Furthermore, the Organiser is liable for damages in connection with the Competition only in the case of blatant gross negligence. The Organiser is liable for personal injury within the limits of the law.
- 3.4. Disputes arising from the conditions of participation or in connection with the Competition are subject to the jurisdiction of the court responsible for 6100 Seefeld.
- 3.5. Disputes arising from the conditions of participation or in connection with the Competition are subject to Austrian substantive law, excluding Austrian conflict of law rules.
