💥 | The Geisterklamm, or Spirit Gorge, is a popular destination that draws families and adventurers to Leutasch, especially on hot summer days. The long gorge circuit stretches 3.2 km, winding through the spectacular Leutascher Ache river gorge. Along the way, the spirits tell you all about your surroundings and the gorge's flora and fauna. A more leisurely option is the wheelchair accessible, 500-metre-long short gorge circuit with views of the crystal-clear river. Another highlight is the waterfall trail, which you can get to by following the Mittenwald circuit that branches off by the panoramic bridge. From the gorge exit near Mittenwald, the 200-metre-long waterfall trail descends deep into the Leutasch Spirit Gorge to the 23-metre-high waterfall (entrance fee). Sturdy footwear is recommended, especially on this somewhat steeper path. The gorge is easily accessible by bus, and parking is available for those arriving by car (charges apply).

The bell is adorned with the coats of arms of the ARGE ALP countries and was newly cast in 2023 by master craftsmen at the Grassmayr bell foundry. As the largest free-standing bell in the Alps, it is the main attraction of the Peace Hiking Trail, which offers breathtaking views over the Inn Valley. This attraction draws visitors in both summer and winter and can easily be combined with other hikes and bike tours.




