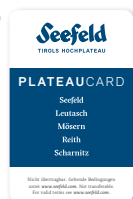

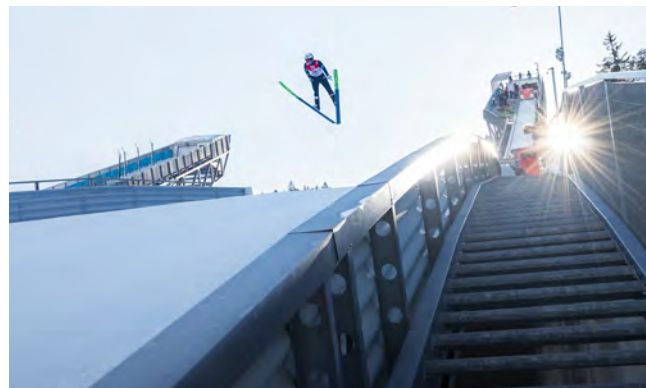

Learn how to sled properly and finally get the hang of it.
(21.12.2025 – 15.03.2026)



Want to get the most out of your sled and finally master those tight turns safely? Harry, a certified sledding guide from Leutasch, explains how to use your equipment efficiently to sled faster, while coming to a stop more safely and with greater control. Take the chairlift up to the Katzenkopfhütte, where we'll stop for refreshments before the descent. For optimal control, you need a steerable toboggan – this is flexible and have slanted and curved runners.

Required equipment: steerable toboggan, helmet, warm clothing (including gloves), ski goggles or sunglasses, shoes with good tread, and, if necessary, crampons with short spikes.
